Our unique rolling programme aims to equip individuals with the tools that enable them to make empowering life choices, deterring them from anti-social behaviour and more serious criminal activity. Our programme is delivered across the community and is made up of the following core elements:

- **It wasn't me'** crime consequence expert witness presentation delivered by a former offender - Their story and the journey includes accounts of how they have held themselves accountable and responsible for their actions and rehabilitation.
- **The victim voice workshop** - This session is delivered by a victim of crime and puts a 'Face to crime'
- **Social engagement workshop** – This session helps individuals to understand the effects of good and poor decision making, supporting their understanding in the role that they play with making positive life choices as well as understanding how crime impacts on the community.

We would like to hear from anyone that has experience of the Criminal Justice System and is confident of being able to speak in front of large groups, but equally being engaging in a one to one situation.

We particularly welcome applications from ex-offenders and from all sections of the community regardless of race, gender, sexual orientation, religion, age or disability.
